

Marsway Food + Nature – disposable fast-food tableware made from sugar cane bagasse

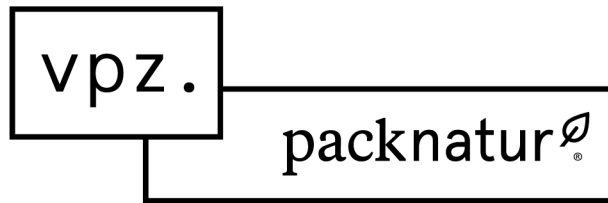
A sweet solution for the catering industry



Marsway Food + Nature's tableware is composed of 99.5% sugar cane bagasse. The other 0.5% represents natural binding agents. An economic alternative for serving fast food.

100% sugar cane produces around 35% sugar.

Like so many manufacturing processes, producing sugar also produces waste. Yet in this case, this waste is put to good use. The fibrous residue that is left over from sugar production is mixed into a pulp with water, which is then pressed into trays and sold as disposable tableware by Marsway Food + Nature. The tableware comes in a wide range of shapes and sizes. The plates and dishes hold their shape well, are water- and oil-proof, and safe to use in the freezer, microwave and oven. They can even be used for



baking dishes such as lasagne, withstanding temperatures up to 250°C. Cakes can also be turned out easily, without the need to use a release agent. Most of the products are available with a lid, but they can also be covered with film or foil just as easily.

The tableware is certified safe for use with food and is compostable.
